Job Title: PhD student in biophysics

Job Summary:

PhD student will be involved in realization of the project "Interactions of amyloid beta peptides with metal ions and lipid membranes: Insights from lattice and all-atom simulations" devoted to molecular simulation of aggregation of proteins which is associated with neurodegenerative diseases including the Alzheimer's disease.

Job Description:

A successful candidate is expected to develop coarse-grained models to describe aggregation of polypeptide chains on membranes and to perform all-atom molecular dynamics simulations to study the impact of lipid bilayer membranes on self-assembly of amyloid beta peptides bound to Cu(II).
